Introduction

General Principles

White Star Medical Services Ltd are committed to achieving high standards of risk management.

White Star Medical Services Ltd expects staff, learners, visitors, contractors and other employers to share this commitment by complying with White Star Medical Services Ltd policies and procedures, and to understand that they too have legal and moral obligations to themselves and to one another.

White Star Medical Services Ltd will therefore make available risk assessments for staff and public including but not limited to the generic training and generic event cover risk assessments.

Risk assessments should be carried out for all activities. An activity should not be undertaken without a risk assessment. It is up to the individual member of staff to ensure they have the correct training and equipment as laid out by the appropriate risk assessment.

Dynamic risk assessments are to be carried out by lead trainers and event officers when arriving at any new site. This must be documented and submitted to head office within 7 working days of the event.

White Star Medical Services Ltd will review these risk assessments to ensure appropriate controls are in place.

We undertake to continually review and develop our safety management systems, with the overarching aim of conducting our activities in a manner which does not affect the health and safety of any staff, learners, contractors or visitors, or adversely affect the environment.
